ELIGIBILITY:

Students will be admitted into the Honors Program at the end of the spring semester of their Junior year, after having completed 18 credits in Classics at Rutgers, New Brunswick, and 90 credits overall by the beginning of the fall semester in which they enter the Honors Program. A 3.6 average in Classics courses and a 3.2 overall GPA is required for admission. Students may take a maximum of 15 credits during either semester while working on an Honors thesis.

Acceptance in the program is subject to approval by the department Chair. **The initial deadline for Classics honors applications is Monday, May 17th.** Should any spaces remain after that date, the next deadline for applications will be **July 30th.** Space is limited: please register early. Special permission numbers to register will be distributed after acceptance into the program during mid-summer.
